Day First (February 09, 2023)

The 7-day NSS camp to be held from 9 to 15 February 2023 at village-Jaisinghpura,

Assandh was inaugurated today by Principal Vikas Atri. Extending best wishes to the NSS volunteers for this camp, he said that students are not just there to get education.





Rather, they should also try to think how they can use the education which they have acquired to provide benefits to the society.

The day started with NSS song. Thereafter the volunteers were divided into four groups by Heena, Assistant Professor to inculcate the spirit of selfless service and voluntary work in NSS volunteers.



In the morning session, Nisha Rani interacted with the volunteers about Digital India. She told that the objective of the Digital India program is to make every Indian aware about electronic

and digital means and to make India strong in the digital sector, under this program every region of India has to be connected with the Internet.



In the evening session, Sanjeev Kumar, NSS Incharge told the volunteers that how the National Service Scheme inculcates national and social values among the students, and due to this values the volunteers played an important role during the Covid pandemic. During this Principal Vikas Atri, Sanjeev Kumar, Heena, Amrit Kaur and all the volunteers were present.



Day Second (February 10, 2023)

The second day of the 7-day NSS camp running from 9 to 15 February 2023 at village-Jaisinghpura, Assandh started with the NSS song.

In the morning session, a rally was taken out by NSS volunteers to create awareness among the people about "Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao" in village Jaisinghpura, which was flagged off by Mr. Rohtash, Assistant Professor.

In the last session of the day, Surat Singh and Naresh Kumar, Himani Institute of Fire Safety, Assandh gave a talk to the NSS volunteers on "How to be saved in case of fire" and also

Day Third (February 11, 2023)

The third day of the 7-day NSS camp running from 9 to 15 February 2023 at village-Jaisinghpura, Assandh also started with an NSS song.





Today's morning session was based on the topic "Road Safety Rules and Regulations". Ashok, Retd, Karnal Traffic Police and Sanjeev Sharma were invited to talk to the volunteers in

detail on this topic. He told the children that with a little vigilance and caution on the roads, many accidents can be avoided. Understanding road side sign boards and traffic signals is as important as driving carefully on the road.



While driving on the highway or main road, speed control or blind turn signal should be taken care of frequently. Some volunteers also presented a drama related to road safety rules and regulations so that everyone can be made aware of road safety.



The session that followed was based on the theme "Legal Awareness" in which Diksha, Advocate, Assandh was invited as the keynote speaker. He told that the meaning of legal awareness

is to empower the public by making them familiar with the general things related to the law. This awareness promotes legal culture. People's participation in making of the laws increases and progress is towards made the establishment of the rule of law. That's why every

Day Forth (February 12, 2023)



So that he can get relief as soon as possible while taking him to the hospital. He explained to everyone, knowing what not to do is more important than what to do during an emergency. Because, wrong treatment can increase the risk of death of that particular person.







In the afternoon session, the volunteers took up the task of cleaning the campus under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan under the slogan 'Hum sab ka yeh sapna, Swachh parisar ho apna'. In which all the volunteers worked to make everyone aware of cleanliness by ensuring collective participation.





Day Fifth (February 13, 2023)


On the fifth day of the 7day NSS camp a "Health Checkup and Awareness Camp" was organized for the volunteers. In which mainly HIV/AIDS TB, H.B. And eye checkup was done.



Rangi Ram, ICTC, Counselor said that HIV is a type of virus which attacks our immune system and weakens it. This virus attacks the immune system until the person dies. After this Satish Kumar T.B. Gave complete information about and Ekta Malik talked in detail with children about how to avoid mental diseases. In this health check-up camp, the children's eyes were also examined and they were also told how they can take care of their eyes.



After this a "Poster Making Competition" was organized for the volunteers. Through this "Poster Making Competition" they had to tell what they have learned from the National Service Scheme.
